Our Church was built in 1982, after losing the previous building to a fire. We are located on one of the main streets of Sparta in the downtown area. We have a large kitchen and fellowship hall where we serve coffee after our church service. We have a large office for the minister with an adjoining office for our church secretary. Our greatest assets of the church are our members and the warmth and friendliness of our fellowship together.

Our church is governed by the church council which follows our adopted constitution. The boards/committees consist of Board of Deacons, Board of Trustees, Board of Stewardship and Mission, Board of Christian Education, and Nominating Committee. The chairperson of those boards/committees comprises the church council along with the elected positions of moderator, financial secretary, and treasurer.
