We serve the community in many ways including renting our Fellowship Hall to a private Day Care, four classrooms to an alternative school, and a Haitian church uses the sanctuary for two services.

One paragraph summary of the church's history:

Our 104-year-old church, Community United Church of Christ began in 1918. In 1925-26, thirty-five charter members hired a pastor and a house in the community was donated to become a parsonage.

In 1938, the church acquired the Community Club and converted it into a church.

The church became affiliated with the Congregational Church in 1947. Later a Fellowship Hall, parsonage and an educational wing were added to the site.

We became Community United Church of Christ in the 1960's. In 1982, the narthex was added with stained glass windows to match the sanctuary's stain-glass windows. They make an impressive entry into the sanctuary.
