1. WHO ARE WE TODAY – description of who you are as a church, and your vision and mission statement

In 1930, three Evangelical and Reformed Churches: St.Peter's (Miltonsburg), St.John's (Middle Church), and St. Peter's (Lewisville) were united as the Lewisville Charge with one minister to serve them. In 1955, these churches, combining resources, built Fellowship Hall where social activities were held. On Sept. 2, 1962, the three churches voted to unite into one congregation under the name Trinity United Church of Christ. Fellowship Hall became the church now known as Trinity UCC.

We believe in the triune God: Creator resurrected Christ, the sole Head of the church, and the Holy Spirit, who guides and brings about the creative and redemptive work of God in the world. We believe that each person is unique and valuable. It is the will of God that every person belongs to a family of faith where they have a strong sense of being valued and loved. We believe all are welcome and united by God's love. For the United Church of Christ, Justice and Jesus are inseparable. Our daily worship is anchored by the belief that "God is still speaking."

The purpose of this church shall be to worship God, to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ, to celebrate the Sacraments, and to realize Christian fellowship and unity within this church and the Church Universal, to render loving service toward mankind and to strive for righteousness, justice, and peace.
