First UCC Eastlake is made up of a few different churches. The Evangelical church in Willoughby closed and combined with First Congregational Eastlake to become First UCC Eastlake in 1962. The 2 locations built a new church in a new location. In 2021 the congregation voted to sell that church/land and buy a closed Lutheran church to set up the church for future financial stability. The church has strong family roots, 2nd and 3rd generation. Our mission statement; Witnessing to God's love to grow in our community and beyond through service and worship. As a congregation we embrace the words 'no matter who you are or where you are in life's journey you are welcome and wanted here". We are a small friendly church with a lot to offer.

2. WE LIVE OUT OUR VISION AND MISSION THROUGH THE FOLLOWING – worship, faith formation, care and fellowship, mission and outreach opportunities:

-Worship- Church starts at 10:00 AM every Sunday. We offer adult education through bible study throughout the year. The children of the church are included in the services and Sunday school is offered. Communion is offered to all in attendance watch week.

-Fellowship- Once a month we do fellowship dinner at different local restaurants. Every Sunday we have coffee hour after church. To promote fellowship we have held ice cream socials, lunch after church, Cleveland Browns watch party as well as a campfire. Each year we attend a Lake County Captains game as a church and -OutReach- We have a Girl Scout troop and an AA group that each meet at the church on a weekly basis. We try to help the community in many different ways, we have a food pantry, throughout the year we raise money for different local charities. The other way that we help the community is with the schools, we collect school supplies and breakfast snacks to help kids in need. For the last 3 years we have had a table at the Lake County Pride Festival. to help spread the word that we are open and affirming.
