Summary Ministry Description:

The United Church of Christ's motto, "that they all may be one,"—Jesus' prayer for unity—has shaped Zion's history and identity. For over 150 years, Zion UCC has been a spiritual leader and community presence in the Le Sueur area.

- Community & Care: Members support one another while respecting differences, creating a welcoming, diverse, and caring environment.
- Generations & New Members: Many families have belonged for generations, and we continue to welcome new families who want to follow Christ while being part of a unified community.
- Stability & Strength: Zion is financially sound, debt-free, and supported by established endowments, allowing us to honor our past while moving confidently into the future.

Looking Forward

As we enter this time of transition, Zion seeks an **interim pastor** who can walk with us in faith and provide:

- Spiritual Leadership: Preaching, teaching, and worship that inspire and sustain us.
- **Pastoral Care**: Support and guidance for members in times of need, celebration, and everyday life.
- Steady Presence: Helping us navigate change with courage and hope while honoring our traditions.
- **Discernment & Preparation**: Guiding us as we reflect on our history, assess our present strengths and challenges, and prepare for the call of our next settled pastor.

We are eager to partner with an interim pastor who will nurture our congregation in this in-between time, help us listen for God's call, and strengthen us for the exciting journey ahead.



What we value about living in our area:

We treasure the friendliness of our town, the natural beauty of the Minnesota River Valley, and the strong sense of community that brings families together. Le Sueur is a place where people know each other by name, where neighbors look out for one another, and where families find support and connection.

Community Highlights

- Family-Friendly Spirit: Our excellent schools—including a brand-new elementary school (2024)—and community events, create a nurturing environment for children and families.

SCOPE OF WORK

Ministering to Zion UCC

- ➤ Preparation and leadership of Sunday worship including scripture study, sermon preparation, guiding and sometimes finding lay liturgists, planning of music in coordination with musical staff, preaching, offering of prayers, etc.
- > Guiding faith formation of our youth and young adults along with our Christian Education committee.
- ➤ Pastoral services, such as baptisms, weddings, and funerals.
- > Demonstrating strong and consistent leadership and administration skills.
- > Being energetic, outgoing, engaging, a spiritual guide and a mentor to all.

Ministering to the Community and Wider World

- ➤ Community engagement and leading the way for the church to be an ambassador of God's love.
- ➤ Visiting the hospitalized and the shut-ins.
- > Participate in wider church activities such as conference meetings.
- Availability to wider community for funerals, weddings, special worship programs, and as a representative of the church to local organizations.
- > Pastoral care, listening and referral.

Ministering to the Operation of the Church

- Leadership development by working with people in the church to create ministry and programs.
- > Responsibility for supervision of staff.
- > Strategic planning for current and new directions in ministry.
- Attend meetings and give leadership as needed to church programs, in collaboration with lay leadership.
- > Study and prayer to increase faith and to improve skills to lead, teach, and preach better

Core Competencies:

- A pastor who will continue to improve Zion's mission of developing and supporting youth & young adult faith formation and ministries, as part of our desire to increase youth participation in all aspects of our church's life.
- A communicator who can prepare inspiring, relatable sermons & worship services that speak to the needs of our entire congregation.
- A leader who can nurture and continuously develop lay leadership within the walls of Zion and out into our community, encouraging all members to take an active role in the life of the Church.

COMPENSATION AND SUPPORT

Salary Basis: Fulltime base salary plus a housing allowance will total \$76,000 – 94,000 in accordance with the MN UCC 2025 compensation guidelines, the pastor's experience and Zion's Active Membership total.

Benefits: An additional \$36,000 has been budgeted for benefits. This total will be a negotiated balance of:

- ✓ Medical Insurance
- ✓ Dental Insurance
- ✓ Contributions to the Annuity Fund, an IRS 403(b) tax-sheltered annuity administered by The Pension Boards, United Church of Christ
- ✓ The UCC Life & Disability Insurance plan

<u>Vacation:</u> One week of paid vacation for every 3 months of service. Two additional paid weeks off per year, including Sundays, is expected for continuing education.

What is the expected living situation for your interim minister?

Zion does not own a parsonage, so the pastor will secure their own housing, preferably within the Le Sueur-Henderson school district or as close to Le Sueur as possible.

Comment on the residential/commuting expectations for your interim minister.

Our interim pastor will serve on a hybrid basis, keeping a minimum of 8 weekly office hours (two half-days in the office, on days they determine). Beyond office hours, we ask for timely availability by phone, text, or email for urgent pastoral needs and important church matters. The role also includes active involvement in scheduled church events and meetings as part of our shared ministry.

Describe peer and professional supports available for ministers in your community/conference:

The Minnesota Conference of the UCC provides such support.

WHO IS GOD CALLING TO MINISTER WITH US?

Our church values fellowship and connection, and we feel called to expand these values by welcoming even more people into our community of faith. We believe God is inviting us to become more visible in Le Sueur and beyond, creating opportunities to share Christ's love and engage more deeply with our neighbors.

Our Hopes and Efforts

- **Community Presence**: Growing in visibility through fellowship, outreach, community service, and ecumenical opportunities.
- Youth & Young Adults: Engaging and supporting them as an integral part of our congregation and their faith journey.
- Creative Christian Education:
 - o Continue to focus on our family oriented FuZion program.
 - o Intergenerational meals before faith formation classes.
 - o Combining different age groups to encourage older youth to mentor younger peers.
 - o Grouping grades together to build stronger classroom discussion and participation.
- **Broadcast Ministry**: Continuing to share the Good News through our weekly radio broadcast, reaching across southern Minnesota.

Through these efforts, we seek to be a **vital church** in our community—sharing the gospel, living as the body of Christ, and encouraging the world around us with hope and faith.
